4.A.4(a) <u>New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (AT&T) Second Amendment to Lease</u> Agreement for Water Tower Cell Site

BACKGROUND: New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (AT&T) has proposed adding additional antennas to its existing antenna array located on the City's water tower. In addition to the antennas, they have also requested to add additional ground equipment within their existing allotted footprint. The City will be compensated an additional \$250 per month on its lease payment. This amendment was originally approved by the City in November of 2012, but AT&T wanted additional language added. The original amendment is included with legislative markup.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approve New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (AT&T) Second Amendment Lease Agreement for Water Tower Cell Site.

4.F.1 Agreement for Single Source Ground Ambulance Service

BACKGROUND: The City approved the Agreement for Single Source Ground Ambulance Service with American Medical Response (AMR) in 2010. The Ambulance Service Board recently negotiated revisions to the contract, most notably a reduction of cost to citizens for ambulance service and quicker response times. By approving the contract, the City approves the revisions and extends the contract until 2016.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approve the Agreement for Single Source Ground Ambulance Service.

4.F.2 Acceptance of Donation from American Medical Response

BACKGROUND: Due to electrical problems, Medical Lake Rescue 1 fire truck's radio was destroyed. AMR has offered to donate seven radios to the City for no cost. The other radios can be used as replacements if necessary until all radios are replace later this year by Spokane County.

REQUESTED ACTION: Approve the AMR radio donation.
