4.A.4(a) Resolution 521: Adopting Legislation to Authorize a Sales and Use Tax for Affordable and Supportive Housing in Accordance with Substitute House Bill 1406

BACKGROUND: Please see City Attorney McMullen's staff report. It is important to note that this is not a new sales or use tax, and therefore local residents will not see an increase in their sales tax percent. What HB 1406 does is authorize the state to provide back to communities that participate .0073% of the 6.5% sales tax that is collected by the state. It is also important to note that if the City chooses to not participate, the city's portion will go to Spokane County.

ACTION REQUESTED: Deliberate on Resolution 521.

4.C.1 Agreement for Professional Services with Shea, Carr & Jewell, Inc. for Completion of Shoreline Management Program Update

BACKGROUND: The City is required to review and update their Shoreline Management Program (SMP) every eight years. While Cities within Spokane County are required to complete their update by June of 2021, there is grant funding available in 2020 (the City is eligible for \$16,800) for which Shea, Carr & Jewell, Inc. will apply for on behalf of the City. If grant funding is not secured, the update will not proceed this year.
