Mayor's Minute



July was a busy month. Independence day went well for the most part and without incident. Thank you to those who were safety minded and kept festivities within the approved hours.

Your City Council considered and awarded non-profit ARPA (America Rescue Plan) grants and approved a solid plan for the remainder of the funding to be used for much needed city equipment and infrastructure needs. Thank you council for giving your full attention and extra time to these important decisions. Of the total funding awarded to the city (\$1,611,473) 25% was invested back into our community in the form of awards and grants, see the chart below. Your city government understands the importance of supporting our local businesses and civic groups. Thank you business owners for somehow keeping the lights on during the pandemic and to our civic non-profits for your continued service to our community. \$32,000 of ARPA grant money is still available for non-profit revenue replacements or projects. Applications are available on the city's website or by contacting city hall.

Recruitment for a city administrator continues. Katy Allen served us well for four months during transition and has moved on into retirement, we are grateful for her help. Twelve citizen volunteers and three council members participated in a two-panel interview process, thank you for your time and insights. At the end of the day I decided to keep the recruitment open and appointed Scott Duncan, Public Works Director, as the Interim City Administrator, approved by majority vote of the city council. Congratulations Scott, and thank you!

The city is actively recruiting for a utility clerk, two public works maintenance workers, and a contract city attorney. See the website for applications and information on how to apply.

Briefly in other news, the new website build is underway and is expected to go live sometime in the fall. The Audio Visual equipment upgrades to council chambers will start very soon creating a better virtual experience for viewers. Ptera was awarded \$100,000 of ARPA grant money for startup equipment costs. The agreement for delivery of broadband to homes will be brought to council soon. We at city hall, together with all city departments and your city council, are working together and working hard for you.
