Wildfire Debris Management Community Meeting

SPOKANE COUNTY, Wash. – Spokane County residents impacted by the Gray Road and Oregon Road wildfires are invited to attend a community meeting on Tuesday, August 29, 2023, at 6 p.m. at Riverside High School, 4120 E. Deer Park Milan Rd, Chattaroy, WA 99003.

The meeting will focus on debris management and clean-up, with representatives from [Spokane Regional Clean Air Agency](#), [Sunshine Disposal & Recycling](#), [Washington State Department of Ecology](#), [Waste Management](#), [Spokane County Solid Waste](#), and [Spokane County Emergency Management](#) in attendance.

As residents begin the clean-up process, the need for safe debris removal is vital. Information on where debris can be taken, required testing for asbestos, and proper personal protective equipment will be available.

Spokane County continues to work closely with local, state, and federal partners to aid active response efforts and to help people in Spokane County jumpstart their recovery.
