MAYOR'S MINUTE



Welcome Summertime! The weather has been unseasonably warm giving us for more reasons to be at the lake. The Summer Concert series *Linger at the Lake* is going well. More than

4000 people visited Waterfront Park for the 4th of July Celebration making for a wonderful community event. I hope you enjoyed the city sponsored music and fireworks display!

August marks the one year anniversary of the Gray Road fire. While time seems to have gone by quickly, the recovery process for those displaced has been long. Re*Imagine Medical Lake has worked closely with the Salvation Army and holds a seat on the Spokane Region Long Term Recovery Board. I am grateful to the community members who continue to serve and meet regularly to assist those in the recovery process. FEMA funding came as another layer of relief for more than just those in the lowest income category. I am working on a project now to address help for all, including those paying every cent out of pocket for restoration.

Equally important is the need for future disaster preparedness. How can citizens better prepare for potential wildfires or other disasters. Education is key. How does the city, county, and state better prepare? Through lessons learned the city has already started building in redundant services and are working with a grant funded agency to create a preparedness manual sharable with other cities and counties. I am convinced the state should have a prefunded reserve account available and cities should not have to rely on post-disaster requests for toxic debris removal and recovery assistance. I will be working on that this next legislative session. I will also be asking the legislature to fund Long communities Term Recovery Groups SO experiencing disaster can have access to immediate resources. Stav safe this summer, be mindful of potentially fire dangerous activities, and thank you for your continued support and the kindness shown to each other. We are a great little city! I hope to see you at the park for our final Linger at the Lake and Blue Waters Festival!

10.3 MILES OF LOCAL ROADS RESURFACED

Thanks to a \$1.1 million Transportation Improvement Board grant, a lot of our roads experienced maintenance work and a resurfacing treatment called scrub seal. This project helps extend the life of a roadway for 6-7 years. The City will be applying for additional funds later this year to address the remaining needs throughout our network of streets.

I-90 BUSINESS LOOP SIGNS INSTALLED

WSDOT crews recently installed wayfinding "loop" signage showing how State Route 902 is a mere 13-mile loop that takes travelers through Medical Lake and reconnects to Interstate 90 between exits 264 and 272. This project encourages folks to visit and linger in our eclectic eateries, parks, playgrounds, hiking, biking, boating, and fishing opportunities.

HISTORIC PRESERVATION SERVICES APPROVED

The Spokane County Board of County Commissioners unanimously approved an Interlocal Agreement to allow the Historic Preservation Office to provide their services within the City of Medical Lake. Additionally, the Historic Preservation Office was recently awarded grant funding to explore and document the history of Medical Lake.

SALARY COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION IMPLEMENTED

An Independent Salary Commission was appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council with the express purpose of reviewing and establishing the salaries of the mayor and council members. This citizen advisory board assessed the market rate of compensation for elected city officials, studied the relationship of salaries and the responsibilities of Medical Lake's elected officials, and made a recommendation to provide an increase. The salary schedule was filed on 6/13 and became effective on 7/13 since no referendum petition was filed by citizens. Council members now have a salary of \$325 monthly, and the Mayor has a salary of \$1,400 monthly.
