Updating Medical Lake's Comprehensive Plan

Parks, Recreation, and Natural Areas

The Parks, Recreation, and Natural Areas element of the comprehensive plan supports the other elements of the plan. For example, it supports the quality of life and public health discussions found in the Land Use element and the trails discussion in the Transportation element.

Although this element is not required in the comprehensive plan, a master parks plan is required by the Washington State Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO) in order to qualify for fund-

Recreation and Conservation Office

The Washington State Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO) is a major source of funding for our parks and recreation programs, RCO grants made Waterfront Park possible by funding the softball fields, the pavilion, the boat launch, the beach, etc.

Currently, the City of Medical Lake is waiting to hear about a grant application for funding the replacement of the lighting system for the softball fields at Waterfront Park.

Planning Commission

The topic for the July 25th meeting is Parks, Recreation, and Natural Areas. Meetings start at 5:30 and can be attended in person at City Hall or via Zoom. We encourage you to listen and give your opinion.

New Bus for Recreation Programs

Earlier this year the Parks and Recreation Program purchased a 15 passenger bus. The bus has allowed adult and youth programs to be expanded, including the opportunity for day trips, such as garden tours and summer break day camps.
