## FIREWORK SAFETY 101

### 01 DO NOT LET CHILDREN NEAR FIREWORKS

Fireworks should only be handled by adults or by older children under adult supervision.



### NEVER USE FIREWORKS WHILE IMPAIRED BY DRUGS OR ALCOHOL

Fireworks are dangerous objects that must be handled while under a clear state of mind.

### 03 ONLY LIGHT ONE FIREWORK AT A TIME

Lighting only one firework at a time allows you to manage emergencies should they happen. Never try to relight a malfunctioning firework.



### POINT FIREWORKS AWAY FROM PEOPLE AND BUILDINGS

This helps prevent accidental injuries and fires.

### 05 SOAK SPENT FIREWORKS IN WATER BEFORE DISCARDING

Spent fireworks may still have the potential to relight.
