Did you know Waterfront Park has not been owned by the City of Medical Lake? That's right. For 50 years we have leased and maintained the park and trail system. You likely didn't know the City of Medical Lake had gifted 80 acres to the State of Washington in 1890 for the building of Eastern State Hospital which I discovered some years ago; I thought it only fair to ask for a return of some gifted land for parks and trails. Once in office, staff and I began working on that idea. This legislative session, City Administrator Sonny Weathers, Councilmembers Spiers and Kennedy, and I traveled to Olympia with a request for funding to purchase Waterfront Park. With this being a very difficult budget year, funding was unlikely. With help from our 6th district representatives, it happened! The State of Washington gifted a transfer of more than 60 acres to the City of Medical Lake which includes Waterfront Park and Trail along with funding to pay for the closing costs which must happen by May 2026. Cost to the city? Zero! Congratulations, Waterfront Park now belongs to you! Enjoy!

City Council Corner

6-Year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Adopted. A Public Hearing took place during the 6/3 City Council meeting, reviewing and discussing the short-range transportation plan updated annually and showing funding sources and amounts for transportation improvement projects. See the minutes June-3-2025-City-Council-Minutes.pdf. The plan was adopted on 6/17.

Municipal Court Interlocal Agreement with Airway Heights. City Council discussed options for municipal court services and recently approved a new Interlocal Agreement with the City of Airway Heights, which will result in facilities, materials, and personnel to adjudicate criminal charges, civil matters, and infractions in conformance with Medical Lake Municipal Code, state law, and court rules beginning in January 2026. The existing agreement with Cheney expires 12/31/2025.

Comprehensive Plan Periodic Update. The City is grateful for the survey responses to our recent Communication Preferences and Pulse of the Community Surveys. Summaries are in work and will be shared on the City website soon. Stay tuned for ways you can contribute to refining the vision and values of Medical Lake!
