New Parking Standards up for Adoption

The chapter of the Medical Lake Municipal Code pertaining to parking (Chapter 17.36), adopted in 1999, is being revamped to compliment the recently adopted zoning districts and reflect today's community values. The public is encouraged to review the information, ask questions, and provide opinions. The standards will be discussed at both [Planning Commission](#) and [City Council](#) meetings.

DRAFT Transportation Master Plan

Using Periodic Update grant money from the Department of Commerce, the City of Medical Lake contracted with Ardurra to create the City's first Transportation Master Plan.

The meeting starts at 5:30 in City Hall. A public hearing will be held at the June 25th meeting where you will have another opportunity to comment.



The Transportation Master Plan establishes a long-term framework for developing and maintaining a safe, efficient, and well-connected transportation system. Having an adopted plan provides a framework for decision making and strengthens the City's ability to compete for state and federal funding, ensuring that local resources are used more effectively.

In addition to goals and policies that guide transportation decisions, the Plan has lists of priority projects for the next 6 years, the next 20 years, and beyond.

City Council will consider adopting the Plan on July 21st at 6:30 pm.
